Dear Prospective Waldorf Parents,

Thank you for your inquiry for the 2009-2010 school year. Enclosed you will find written information about the Waldorf School on the Roaring Fork, which should be helpful in introducing you to the principles and philosophies that make us unique. We realize that researching schools for your child can be an overwhelming experience and we are ready to assist you in any way we can. If you have any questions about any of the materials, please feel free to call me.

Currently we have an open enrollment policy at the Waldorf School on the Roaring Fork. This means that, if there are openings in a class, we have the ability to accept students at any time during the school year. Some of our classes are at capacity - for those classes applicants are placed on the wait list. Application information is enclosed. If you have any questions about this process I will be happy to work with you more closely.

Please note that as of June 2007, we have adopted the following "Entrance Assessments for Entering Grades Students' Policy": All children applying to the grades from outside the Waldorf School on the Roaring Fork are required to have an assessment by one of the School's Student Support Teachers prior to acceptance. This assessment should be done prior to or within the first two weeks of the sixty-day trial period. This assessment would be at cost to the parents as an entrance assessment fee. If the student has had a comparable assessment at another Waldorf School within the past year this assessment requirement may be waived at the teacher's discretion.

To fully appreciate what is offered at our school, please come and visit our beautiful 13-acre campus with its strawbale buildings and 11,000 sq. ft. performance hall and experience Waldorf Education in action. We have numerous events throughout the school year for you to do just that. All are wonderful occasions to hear about our philosophy, see student work, and ask questions of our faculty and administrators. We offer school tours the first Thursday of every month. After we receive your completed application you will be scheduled for an interview with the class teacher. If your child is entering school well into the school year they will visit their prospective classes for one week. Please call for more information regarding this process.
