Dear Prospective Waldorf Parents,

Thank you for your inquiry for the 2016-2017 school year. As you navigate through our website you will find information about the Waldorf School on the Roaring Fork, which should be helpful in introducing you to the principles and philosophies that make us unique. To fully appreciate what is offered at our school, please come and visit our beautiful 13-acre campus with its strawbale buildings, 11,000' performance hall and close proximity to the beauty of the wetlands. We offer a 'Walk Through the Grades...School Tour and Observation' the third Thursday morning in September, October, January, and April. This is an excellent opportunity to experience the curriculum first hand. Along with the Tour there are numerous other events throughout the school year that you are welcome to attend. Each event provides an occasion to hear about our philosophy, see student work, and ask questions of our faculty and administrators. Currently we have an open enrollment policy, which means we accept applications throughout the school year. This spring, applications for new students will be processed with the appropriate teacher after our current re-enrollment period closes on March 6th, 2016. By mid March we are able to determine the number of spaces available in each class and begin the interview process for new applicants. We hope to contact all new applicants by March 14th, 2016

To begin the enrollment process, please visit TADS: <http://mytads.com/a/waldorfroaringfork>. All students applying for Preschool, Kindergarten, or our Grades program are required to complete the entire admissions process through TADS, which includes a \$225.00 application fee.

The class teacher will schedule an interview and, if applying for the grades, a time for your child to visit the class for 3-5 days. All prospective students for the Grades program are required to have an assessment by our Student Support Teacher during this visit. Children with a birthday between March 1, 2010 and May 31, 2010 will be assessed for first grade readiness and the school will have a conversation with the family to discuss class placement.
